

2024 HONOUR ENSEMBLE ONLINE APPLICATION INFORMATION

Please read the complete package, complete the forms, and attach them and your audition recording to your online registrations. Applications must be completed by **Friday May 3rd, 2024**. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

To be eligible to apply, students must be an active participant in their school's music program at the time of the audition as well as the time of participation in the Honour Ensemble and be sponsored by a BCMEA member. If the student's teacher is not a BCMEA member it is the student's responsibility to find a BCMEA member who will sponsor the application. If your teacher is unsure about their membership status, please ask them to enclose a membership form and payment with your application package, or contact the BCTF Membership Department.

Online Application/Audition Process

- 1. Print this application form
- 2. Complete Participation Agreement Form
- 3. Ask your teacher to complete the Teacher Reference Form the link is on the Honour Ensembles website
- 4. Make your Audition Recordings for primary instrument/voice and alternate/doubles only mp3 format will be accepted. Record each requirement on a separate track (not necessary for students doing live auditions).
- 5. Complete online registration with all components (attach Participation Agreement and mp3 recordings)
- 6. Students will need to register for each ensemble they are applying for separately
- 7. **Music teachers will be emailed directly** regarding the Teacher Reference Form once your application has been successfully submitted.

A package with audition results for all applicants will be sent to music teachers by Friday June 14, 2024

Rehearsal Schedules

Students selected to participate in an Honour Ensemble **must attend all** rehearsals and performances listed below. Any student not in attendance for all or part of any rehearsal (including the regional rehearsal) may be asked to withdraw from the ensemble without refund of participation fees. **Ensemble Coordinators will confirm the exact dates, times, and locations for rehearsals in an information package sent to successful applicants**.

Pre-Conference Rehearsals

Pre-conference rehearsals are held on Saturdays or Sundays at the end of September or beginning of October. The exact dates will be included in the package successful applicants will receive on June 14, 2024 upon acceptance to an ensemble.

Membership Fees

The membership fee for participating students is \$175. Membership fees pay for the costs of the Honour Ensembles program - conductors' salaries and expenses, music, rehearsal and performance venues, and TOC costs for coordinators. Fees will be paid online after students are accepted into an Honour Ensemble.

Accommodation

Because of liability and risk factors, ensemble coordinators are no longer able to arrange billeting for students. Parents are responsible for arranging accommodations for their children. In the past, students who have chosen not to billet have stayed with family or friends, or had a parent supervise in a hotel with a group of students from a school or district. Please ask your music teacher for help to connect with other students from your school and district and the possibility of financial support from their school and/or local community organizations.
